We have recently been informed that we have to conduct training on new equipment for this year's elections before conducting the equipment testing. We know it's short notice and we usually have more time to schedule training closer to election day! We would love to have you be part of the team and can make this work!

We have coordinated with the County Clerk to offer training in Grand Ledge in an effort to provide closer training to home. We have scheduled three training sessions at City Hall, 310 Greenwood St., Grand Ledge, to cover the new equipment, and election procedures both generally and specific to Grand Ledge. If you are interested, please make every effort to attend one of these training sessions:

- Wednesday, June 27, 2018 - 9:00am to 12:30pm
- Wednesday, June 27, 2018 - 1:30pm to 5:00pm
- Thursday, June 28, 2018 - 1:30pm to 5:00pm

Please remember, training is required by Michigan Election Law and without it you will not be eligible to work at an election for the next two years. You will be paid the standard rate of \$9.00 per hour for attending a training session, but the City does not reimburse mileage costs.
