

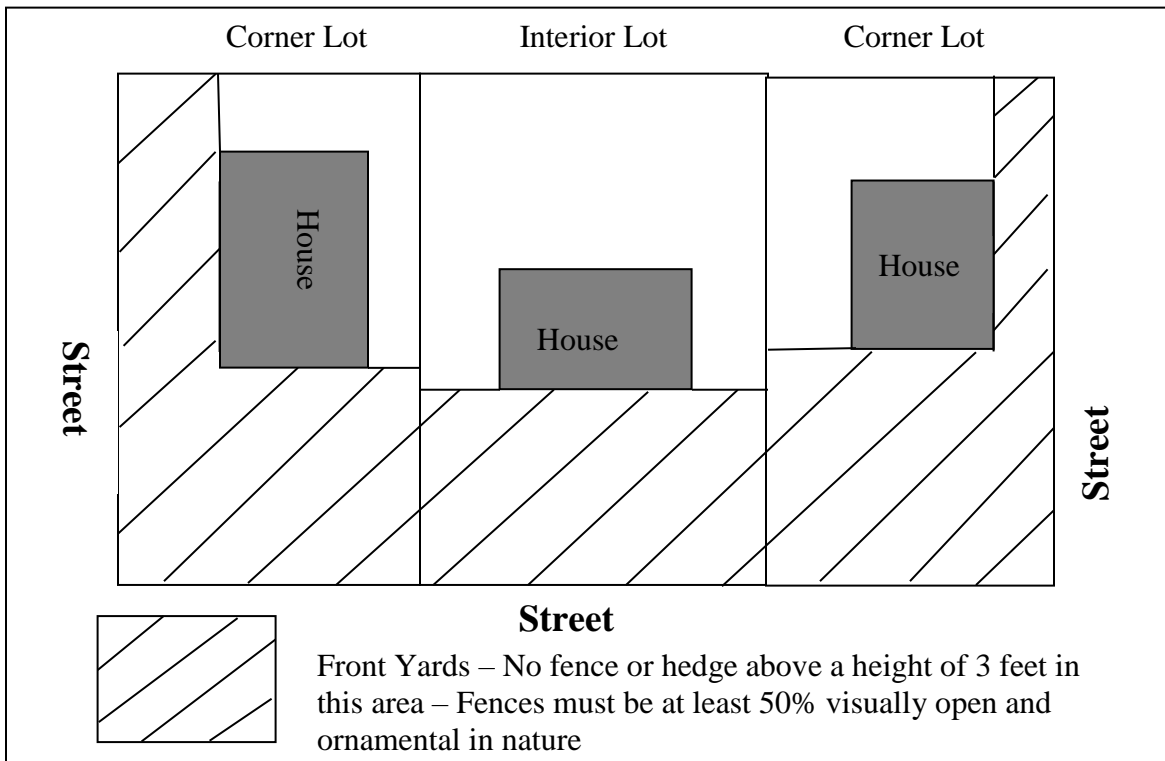
BASIC FENCE/HEDGE ORDINANCE REGULATIONS

No hedge shall exceed a height of 3 feet within a front yard or 6 feet within a side or rear yard.

Fences may not exceed a height of 6 feet within a side or rear yard. When located within a front yard, fences may not exceed a height of 3 feet and must be of an ornamental nature, including picket, split rail or wrought-iron-style fencing, with at least 50% open spaces, uniformly distributed along the surface of the fence. Wire and chain link fencing is prohibited in front yards.

Corner Lots are considered to have two (2) front yards. All yards that abut a street right-of-way are considered front yards, regardless of which direction the house faces.

No fence shall be located in such a manner as to create a dead space between an existing fence or building and a proposed fence.



A fence permit and a fee of \$25.00 are required prior to constructing a fence.
