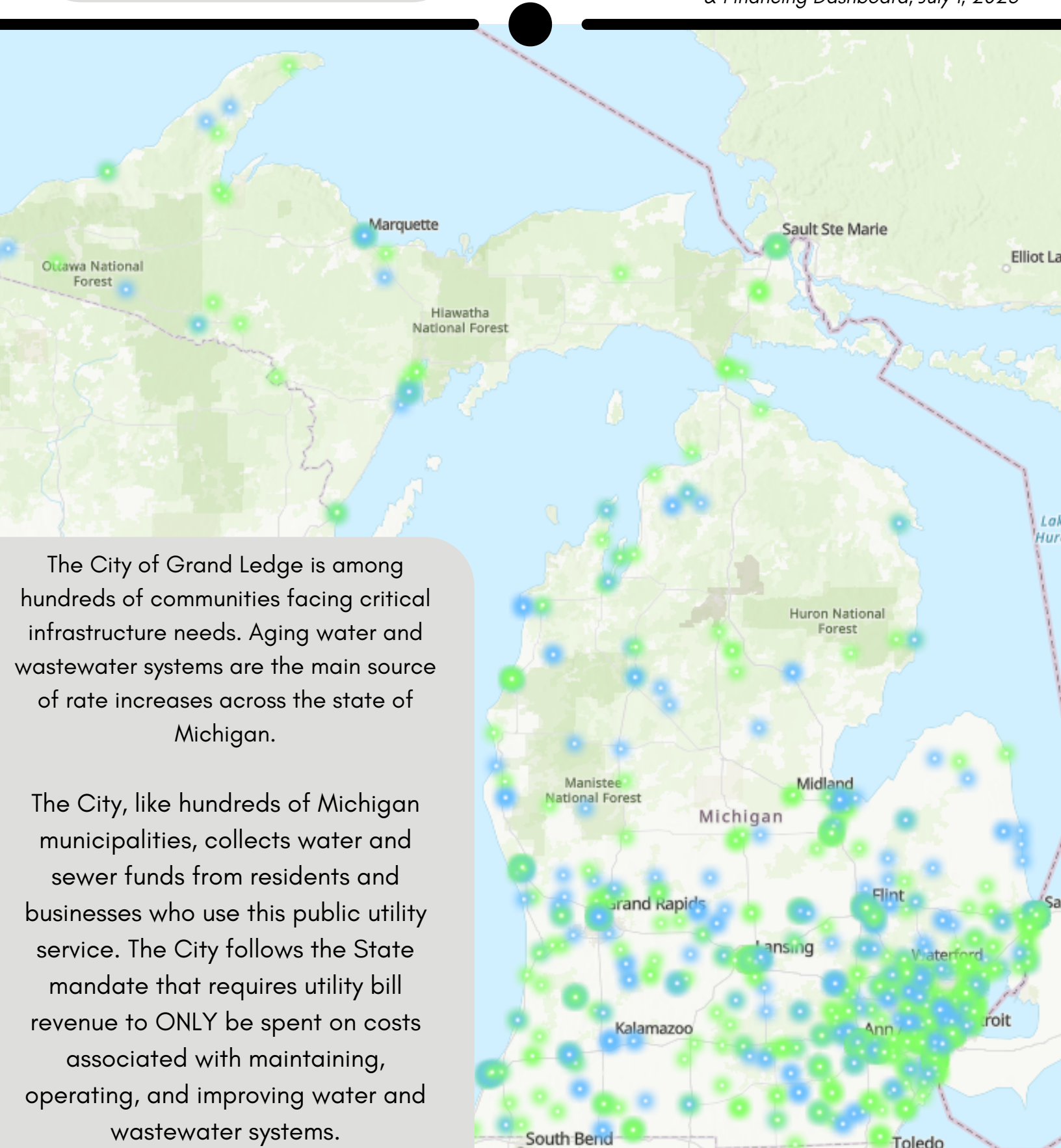


Infrastructure Improvement Initiatives in Michigan
