**RE:** IMPORTANT NOTICE OF LEDGEMOOR BLVD / MORTON ROAD / OLD POST ROAD / MCDIARMID LANE RECONSTRUCTION

On **Tuesday, Sept. 26, 2017** a street improvement project is tentatively scheduled to begin in the areas indicated on the map below. The existing pavement will be removed, followed by excavation of the street base (to a depth of one foot), and installation of a gravel road base. A base layer and final layer of pavement will then be applied. The entire improvement project is estimated to take approximately three weeks.

**Tentative Schedule**

**How do I access my home during the improvement project?**

Residents will have access to their homes during the construction process, with the exception of a time period lasting up to one (1) day while excavation takes place in front of their home, and on paving days. In the event that residents are unable to directly access their home, we ask that vehicles are parked on an adjacent street.

**Why is the schedule ‘tentative’?**

Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of a street resurfacing project. The City will provide updates via [www.cityofgrandledge.com](http://www.cityofgrandledge.com) and residents can also call the Public Services Department, Monday – Friday between 8:00am – 5:00pm at 517-627-2149.

**How will this affect bus stops?**

Bus stops in the noted sections will not be impacted for morning and afternoon routes, with the exception of paving days. On these days, the city will coordinate with GLPS Transportation.
