RE: IMPORTANT NOTICE JONES STREET PAVING

On **Friday, Nov. 3, 2017** the street paving process is tentatively scheduled to begin in the area indicated on the map below. During the paving process **on Nov. 3, the noted section will be closed to ALL traffic.** Residents in the noted section will not have access to their driveways. *Please note: during paving, there will be flagmen directing traffic at the intersections of Jones and Kennedy and Jones and Green. Please use caution while navigating this area.*

Jones Street dead end residents: You will have access to your home with the exception of a short period of time (approximately 30 minutes) during the paving process through the intersection of Jones and Kennedy streets. Residents needing to use their vehicles during that 30 minute period should park on Kennedy Street north of the Jones intersection.

Why is the schedule 'tentative'?

Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of a street resurfacing project. The City will provide updates via www.cityofgrandledge.com and residents can also call the Public Services Department, Monday – Friday between 8:00am – 5:00pm at 517-627-2149.
