


NOTICE - CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE: Driveway Interruptions



DATE: August 6, 2018

TO: Residents on Green Street (Jones to Seminary)

FROM: City of Grand Ledge, Public Service Department

On Monday, June 18, 2018, a project to reconstruct Green St. between Jones St. and Seminary St. began. The project includes water main replacement (including water services to the shut-off near the sidewalk), storm water drainage improvements, and street reconstruction. The street portion of the project includes removal of the existing surface, installation of a sand and gravel road base, and application of new pavement. The existing curb, driveway approaches, and sidewalk on the east and west sides of Green St. will also be replaced as part of the work. Please refer to the following schedule for information regarding driveway access interruptions.

Tentative Construction Schedule for Green Street

Date	Activity	Impact to Residents
Wednesday, August 8, 2019 – Saturday, August 18, 2018	Curb & Driveway Approach Construction	As curb and driveway approaches are reconstructed, residents in the indicated section on Green Street may not have access to their driveways during this period. However, during this construction homeowners will be able to park in front of their homes on Green Street.
PAVING TO FOLLOW	PAVING Green Street 8:30am – 4:00pm	ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM 8:30am – 4:00pm. Residents within the indicated section will not have access to their driveways. To have access outside of the noted section on Green Street, residents must park their vehicles on one of the adjacent streets PRIOR to 8:00am. On-street, overnight parking will be permitted during this construction period.

Where do I park?

Residents in the indicated section of Green Street **can find alternate parking** options on adjacent streets. *Please note: Grand Ledge Police Department has been notified of this construction project and will not be issuing tickets for over-night on-street parking in this area.*

Why is the schedule ‘tentative’?

Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of the construction project. The City will provide updates via www.cityofgrandledge.com. The City advises all pedestrians and vehicles to use caution while navigating around construction.
